



Hygge (pronounced Hoo-gah) is the concept of creating a welcoming, relaxed and nurturing environment — and the trend builds upon the Scandinavian narrative of simpler lines, lighter wood tones punctuated with colorful accents and nature motifs. The environment looks to fresh woodgrains with a more natural matte finish, relaxed colorful textiles, artisanal and vintage finishes. This is Nordic Décor refreshed – with creamy whites and lime washed woods accented by multiple blue tones, with the warmth of linen, caramel, chocolate and leather colorations.


















This lifestyle design trend is being embraced in many areas, including residential and hospitality. Wabi Sabi is the ancient Japanese world view centered on impermanence and imperfection, interpreted today by embracing organic authenticity in design. The focus is on the use of natural materials, with functional items in focus and plenty of intentional negative space. Organic materials such as; rustic woodgrains, worn leathers and raw metals in addition to the matte and pearlescent tones of well-used pottery items represent this thoughtful, understated approach. The muted colors and finishes found in the natural world such as the heavier dark greys, blues and greens as well as the lighter beach grass and eucalyptus tones are the counterpoint to softly reflective patina'd metallic elements.







High Tech appreciates High Touch – comfortable, relaxed yet uncluttered and connected. 





Reculture is the recreation of design classics with the help of contemporary ideas. Timeless, traditional schemes are reimagined – unexpected colors, fabrics and sizes give new life to time honored lines. 



Moderated Modern (Mod<sup>2</sup>) captures the fresh and updated take on some more traditional looks such as Mid Century Modern, Modern Farmhouse (think Joanna Gaines) and Modern Industrial. 
